Fairfield is a rural district in South Central Kansas that serves 300 students and covers 437 square miles.



Fairfield is considered “frontier” rather than rural for federal funding purposes. This comes with both pluses and minuses.



Fairfield School is not on a public water supply or a public water treatment system. As a result, updating the 50 year old septic system was a high priority for both the school district, the county health department and KDHE.



Con Edison served as the general contractor and worked closely with KDHE to develop an approved plan. They were instrumental in navigating the state and federal rules and regulations that govern waste water treatment systems.



The project had to be completed before school began in August 2012 and, despite weather complications, the project was completed on time.
